Dogs—Licenses

REQUIRED:

ALL dogs 5 months of age at any time during the year MUST be licensed ANNUALLY, per Wisconsin Statutes (Wis. Stats. 174.05).



PAPERWORK REQUIRED:

Proof of current rabies vaccination (paperwork is valid, just the tag is not).

LICENSE FEES:

Spayed/Neutered dogs =
\$5.00 each

Unspayed/Unneutered dogs =
\$10.00 each

Multiple Dog (Kennel) =
\$40.00 (up to 12 dogs)

Late Fee = (Beginning on April 1st)
\$10.00 additional fee per dog

**Licenses are valid from
January 1st—December 31st**

Dogs—Leash Law

**ALL dogs
MUST be on a leash
when off their home property.**



Dogs are **NOT** allowed to run at large per State Statute and Town Ordinance.

Voter I.D. Information



Changes to the election process
effective in Spring, 2012, and for
all subsequent elections:



**Voters in the State of Wisconsin
will be required to present a valid Photo I.D.
and sign the poll list before receiving a ballot.**

Voter Registration:

In Person/In Clerk's office

Deadline to register in person is 5:00 p.m. on the
Friday before the election (No Saturday, Sunday, or
Monday registration is allowed.)

By Mail

Deadline to register by mail is no later than the
20th day before the election.

You must provide the address where you were
previously registered to vote.

You can no longer use a corroborator in lieu of
proof of residence documentation.

Residency Requirement

You must have lived at your residential address for at
least 28 consecutive days prior to the election.

Absentee Voting:

There is no in-person absentee voting on the Saturday,
Sunday, or Monday before the election.

Arden Schroeder was the founding President of the Drifters
Snowmobile Club that was formed in 1967. For the past 44
years, Arden has contributed countless hours and ideas to
the club and is currently an active member.

When the new Friendship Trail was to be built alongside
the new Highway 10, there was a need for a bridge to be
built over a small waterway. Arden was the main person in
coordinating the bridge construction with the club and the
Town of Clayton. The Drifters built the bridge at Phieffer
Brothers Construction and the Town had Phieffer Brothers
set the bridge in place.

The Drifters Snowmobile Club
wanted to show their appreciation
for all of Arden's efforts to the
club and the local trail system.

Winter Notices



Depositing of Snow on Public Right-of-Way

It is *against the law* to deposit snow or ice upon the roads (State Highways, County Highways, Town Roads), *or to plow snow across* any of the roads listed.



Passing & Following Town or County Snow Plows while they are plowing roads

It is illegal to follow a snow plow closer than 500 feet on roads with a speed limit of more than 35 miles per hour while the snow plow is engaged in snow and ice removal. Do not ***PASS*** a snow plow vehicle on any road!



Garbage & Recycle Containers

Do not place your garbage and recycle containers close to the road.

Place them over your culvert (the house side of your apron).

They become a hazard when placed close to the road or on the shoulder of the road.
